

Said term of seven years next ensuing
the 1st day of November 1896 shall bear
the like proportion to the amount of the
composition set forth in said original
certificate of said Herbert O'Connell
and payable to the Lay Impropriator
as the average price of the barrel of
good marketable wheat for the seven
years preceding the 1st November 1896 as
ascertained from the Dublin Gazette
that is to say the $5\frac{1}{2}$ bears to the
average price of the barrel of good
marketable wheat set forth in said original
certificate that is to say £7. 12. 0 $\frac{1}{2}$
and that the rent charge now payable
in said Parish of Garraunhinnefeake
in lieu of said composition to said
Lay Impropriator be varied and
diminished in the like proportion and
accordingly that the amount of the said
composition payable to the Lay
Impropriator be varied and diminished
from the sum of £ 79. 3. 4 to
the sum of £ 40. 13. 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ by the
year and that the amount of
the rent charge in the said
Parish of Garraunhinnefeake payable
to

to said Lay Impropriator in lieu of
said composition be varied and reduced
from the sum of £ 59. 7. 6 to
the sum of £ 30. 7. 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ by the
year in the said term of 7 years next
ensuing the 1st day of November 1896
And do do further Order that the
assessment and apportionment of the said
composition and Rent charge payable to
said Lay Impropriator in said Parish
of Garraunhinnefeake be varied —
amended and diminished for the said
seven years next ensuing the 1st day
of November 1896 and so as to bear
the like proportion to the amount of the
composition and rent charge payable
to said Lay Impropriator in said
Parish during said term of seven years
next ensuing the 1st day of November
1896 as the original assessment and
apportionment did bear to the said
amount of said original composition
and the rent charge in lieu thereof
payable in said Parish to
said Lay Impropriator under
and by virtue of said original
certificate
