I James Carpenter Commissioner duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made in the Second and Third Years of the Reign of King William the Fourth, entitled "An Act to amend the several Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth Years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland; and to make such Compositions permanent," to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, and payable within the Parish of Gault Hill in the County of Wick, do hereby certify, that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Twenty five pounds by the Year, which sum is due and payable to the Reverend Patrick Punny as a Compositor for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish.

And I do further certify, that the Average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the period of Seven Years ending on the first day of November One Thousand eight hundred and thirty is One pound Twelve Shillings and one halfpenny per Barrel.
