Mr Christopher Bailey and Simon Todd Commissioners duly appointed  
and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the  
Reign of King George the fourth intituled an Act to provide for the Establishing  
of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time and also an Amendment  
of same, to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes aris-  
-ing growing payable or payable within the Parish of Geashill in the Kings  
County and Decree of Rector to the Rev John Digby Wimpfield, Rector  
Certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tithes whatever  
due and payable to the Rector John Digby Wimpfield within the S. Parish  
is One thousand four hundred Pounds by the Year, which sum of One  
thousand four hundred Pounds is due and payable to him the said Rev.  
John Digby Wimpfield as a composition for all tithes claimable by him  
as Rector of the S. Parish to continue for the full term of twenty one  
Years commencing the first day of November next Subject to be varied  
in the seventh and fourteenth Years, and we do further Certify that  
the average price of oats being the Corn principally grown in such  
County for the period of seven Years ending on the first day of No-  
-vember One thousand Eight hundred and twenty One is fifteen Shillings  
and two pence farthing per Acre. Given under our  
hands this 29<sup>th</sup> day of September 1825
