and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of
the Reign of King George the fourth Intituled an Act to provide for the
Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, and
also an Amendment of same, to ascertain and fix a true and just com-
position for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish
of Geashill in the Kings County and Diocese of Ardagh to the Rev^d John
Digby Winfield, do hereby certify that the true and just ^{amount of} composition
for all Tithes whatsoever due and payable to the said Rev^d John Digby
Winfield within the said Parish is One thousand four hundred Pounds
by the year which sum of One thousand four hundred Pounds is due
and payable to him the said Rev^d John Digby Winfield as a compo-
sition for all Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish
to continue for the full term of twenty one years commencing the
first day of November next, Subject to be varied in the seventh
and fourteenth years, and we do further certify that the average price
of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such County for the
space of seven years ending the 31st day of November one thousand
eight hundred and twenty one is fifteen Shillings and two pence
fourthing per Bunch
