of Garrow in the County of Kilkenny and Diocess of Ossory do certify that the True and Just amount of
Composition for all Tithes within said Parish is Five Hundred and Seven pounds thirteen Shillings and
Ten pence farthing British Currency by the year which sum is due and Payable to the Rev^d John Baptist Pidge
as Rector of said Parish and we do further certify that the foregoing written page of this Book contains an
Appraisal for Leasing the sum of Five Hundred and Seven pounds thirteen Shillings and Ten pence farthing
by the year and Payable half yearly for the full term of Forty years without any variation
of Price of Grain Dated this 20th day of June 1826
