

Sir, You are hereby required to take notice that  
That in pursuance of an Act passed in  
the 2<sup>d</sup> and 3<sup>d</sup> years of the reign of His Majesty  
King William the 4<sup>th</sup> entitled <sup>an</sup> Act to amend  
Three Acts passed respectively in the 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>  
and in the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> years of the reign of His  
late Majesty King George the Fourth providing  
for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes  
in Ireland and to make such Compositions  
permanent. - I James Barbor of Moyvate  
being seized by virtue of <sup>an</sup> Indenture of Lease  
from Hon<sup>ble</sup> Denis Donisthorpe for and during two  
lives & 28 years from the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 1804  
of all that and those lands of Triskill the bounds  
whereof are as follow, That is to say bounded on  
the North by Triskill in the County of Longford  
on the South by Triskill, on the East by Maberby  
and on the West by Longwarden situated in the  
Barish of Granard, Barony of Granard and County  
of Longford. Do hereby signify to you my desire  
to agree for and undertake the payment of the  
Composition for Tithes lawfully payable for and  
in respect of the said lands as aforesaid and I  
hereby require you to grant to me a Certificate in  
writing conformable to the provisions of the said Act  
declaring me entitled to the benefit of this  
Notice, and to perform the other matters on your  
part required by the said Act to be done -
