

To all to whom these presents shall come I the Reverend Christopher Robinson Ecclesiastical Incumbent and Vicar of the Parish of Granard in the County of Longford send greeting -

Whereas William Fulke Greville of Marine Parade Dover in the County of Kent in that part of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland called Great Britain Esquire has truly served me with a notice of writing in the words and figures following -

Sir Take Notice that in pursuance of an act passed in the second and third years of his present Majesty's Reign entitled "An Act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth, ~~and~~ fifth and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such compositions permanent." And of an act passed in the third and fourth years of the same reign entitled "An Act for the relief of the owners of tithes in Ireland and for the amendment of an act passed in the last session of Parliament intitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such compositions permanent." I William Fulke Greville of Marine Parade Dover in the County of Kent in that part of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland called Great Britain Esquire do hereby signify my desire and intention to agree for and undertake the future payment of the Compositions and of all sums which shall become due and payable on account of the compositions which under the Laws in force in Ireland for the composition of tithes is now fixed and established as the composition for all tithes for and in respect of the Lands of Aughabrack and Greville a subdenomination thereof, Ballykilbrist, Ballymaerohy, Balnagal, Ballybrien, Ballymorris otherwise Ballymaurie, Balnacross and Kinkillue a subdenomination thereof, Ballymore, Carah, Cartron, Cartronwillan otherwise Grassyard otherwise Grassguard, Church Quarter and Mullingee and Fair Green subdenominations thereof, Galed otherwise Gallad, Granard Kill otherwise Granard Killo, and Thomore a subdenomination thereof, Town of Granard, Higginstown, Lower Killasanna otherwise Lower Killasna, Leitrim, Robinstown, Rathronan, Tubberphelim, Tonyfabble and Trunroe, which said lands are measured and bounded on the North West by the lands of Aughaboy, Coolarty, Muckerstaff and Fullier, on the North by the lands of Coolcor, Rabrackan, Rathcor, and Clough, on the North East by the lands of Dalystown, Aughnagarron, Ballinrud, Cartronbore, Springtown and Mullagh, on the South East by Abbeylaragh, Kilbride, Tonin, Runroe, and Upper Killasanna, and on the South West by Aughamore, Castlemeigant, Friskhill, and Tonywarden, all which lands are situate in the manor parish and Barony of Granard and County of Longford and in which I have an estate title and interest in fee simple and I hereby require you in pursuance of the provisions of the said acts to grant me a certificate under your hand and seal reciting this notice and declaring me entitled to the benefit thereof -
