ability execute and perform the powers and authorities  
vested ~~and~~ reposed in me as a Commissioner in the  
Parish of Grange, by virtue of an Act passed in the fourth  
Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled, "An  
Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes  
in Ireland for a limited time, according to the directions  
of said Act, and according to equity and good conscience  
and without favour or affection, prejudice or malice to any  
person or persons whomsoever. So help me God
