George the Fourth entitled "an Act to provide for the  
establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a  
limited time, according to the directions of said Act, and  
according to equity and good Conscience and without favour  
or affection prejudice or malice to any person or persons  
whomsoever.
