Quarter Sessions held at Carlow in and for the  
County of Carlow on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January  
anno Domini 1855

Whereas it appearing to the Justices of the  
Peace presiding at the Quarter Sessions of the Peace  
for the County of Carlow held at Carlow on the 1<sup>st</sup>  
day of January 1855 that the Right Honble John George Prubagon Esquire  
Earl of Roseborough Thomas Whelan and James Hardy Esquires  
being 3 persons in the Parish of Grangeford in the Diocese of Leighlin  
and County of Carlow charged with the payment of £8 or  
upwards each in respect of Rentcharge in lieu of Tithe composition  
for Tithe in said Parish caused an order in writing signed by them  
to be affixed on 2 successive Sundays on the principal outer door  
of the Roman Catholic Chapel in said Parish of Grangeford being the  
only place of Religious worship in said Parish the last of which  
Sundays not being less than eight days previous to the day of holding  
the Quarter Sessions of the Peace at Carlow in the County of Carlow on  
the 26<sup>th</sup> day of June anno Domini 1854 in which said Parish is  
inserted signifying that if ever their intention to make an application  
to the Justices of the Peace at such Quarter Sessions to have the average  
price of wheat for the seven years preceding to be enquired of and  
ascertained in order that the composition in lieu of which said  
Rentcharge was payable and the said Rentcharge might be diminished  
for the ensuing seven years in proportion to such average price of  
wheat and whereas the said Earl of Roseborough Thomas Whelan  
and James Hardy Esquires having accordingly and in pursuance  
of said <sup>notice</sup> made an application in writing in the terms of said notice  
to the Justices presiding at the Quarter Sessions aforesaid held at Carlow  
in the County of Carlow in which said Parish is inserted on the said  
26<sup>th</sup> day of June 1854 to ascertain the average price of good  
marketable
