

marketable wheat as ascertained in the Dublin Gazette during the seven years preceding their said application and the notice pursuant to the provisions of the Statute in that case made and provided and the other preliminaries provided and required by the Statute in such case having been proved and one Luke Hughes being duly sworn and having given evidence before us that the average price of good marketable wheat per Bushel within the County of Carlow ascertained from and as advertized in the Dublin Gazette for seven years next preceding said application was £1.6.10 per Bushel the said Justices presiding as aforesaid in the presence of Col and attorney for the applicants no person attending for any other party than and there thought it fit pursuant to the Statute in that case made and provided to nominate and appoint William Raymond Fitzmaurice of Everton in the Queens County Esquire an arbitrator to ascertain the average price of a Bushel of good marketable wheat from the Dublin Gazette upon the average of such term of seven years preceding the 1st of November 1834 and to report the same in writing under his hand to the said Justices and the said Justices then and there adjourned the further hearing of such application until the then next Sessions to be held at Carlow aforesaid on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October 1834 and on said 16<sup>th</sup> day of October at the Quarter Sessions for the County of Carlow held at Carlow on the said 16<sup>th</sup> day of October the Justices of the Peace presiding at said last mentioned Sessions further adjourned the further hearing of such application until the then next Sessions to be held at Carlow aforesaid on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1835 and whereas at this Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the County of Carlow held at Carlow on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord 1835 the matter of said application was again moved and brought before the Justices of the Peace presiding at this Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in the presence of the Col and Atty for the said applicants and in the presence of Thomas Crawford Butler Esq one of the attorneys the attorney for the King Robert Hught
