 Commissioner under and by virtue of an Act made in the
 2nd and 3rd years of the reign of William the fourth, to ascertain
 and fix a true and just Compensation for all Tithes aris-
 -ing, growing yielded or payable within the Parish of George
 Macleer in the County of Tipperary do hereby certify that the true
 and just amount of Compensation for all Tithes whatever
 within the said Parish, is Eighty pounds by the year, which
 sum of Eighty pounds is due and payable to Cesar Lutton
 as a Compensation for the Tithes claimable by him as Layman
 -proprietor of the said Tithes of said Parish. And I do
 further certify that the average Price of wheat being the
 Corn principally grown in such County for the period of
 seven years, ending on the first day of November one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty is one pound
 twelve Shillings and one half penny per Barrel
 dated this 29th day of October 1833—
