 of Composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited period of time and
 also of an act made in the fifth year of George the fourth to amend the
 same to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising
 growing, yielded or payable within the parish of Grange Siloe in the County
 of Wicklow do hereby certify that the true and just amount of compo-
 sition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is five hundred pounds
 by the year, the entire of which sum is due and payable to the Incumbent
 the Rev^d John French and his successors, invariably, independently of vicages
 or whatever the price of corn may be for the limited term of twenty
 one years from the date hereof. Given under our hands this 25. day of June 1829.
