

## Tithe Composition

### Parish of Great Connell

I John Symes having been duly appointed and sworn as Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, intituled "an Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" And by Virtue of an Act passed in the Second and Third years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled "an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eight years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, and to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Great Connell, Barony of Great Connell and County of Meath, Do Certify that the True and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is One Hundred and Sixty Nine pounds fourteen Shillings and Sixpence Sterling by the Year, out of which amount the sum of Twenty Nine pounds Nine Shillings and seven pence is due and payable to the Reverend Mathias Crowley as Rector of the Rectorial Tithes arising out of the Townland of Great Connell and part of the Townland of Killeelin in said Parish. And a further sum of Thirty Three pounds Eighteen Shillings and one penny is due and payable to the said Mathias Crowley as Vicar of the Vicarial Tithes arising out of the following Townlands, Viz. Hillsborough alias Oldtown, Colerainings, Rosetown and Herbertstown in said Parish. And a further sum of Twenty pounds Nine Shillings and nine pence is payable to Robert Latouche Esq: as owner of the Rectorial Tithes arising out of the Townland of Hillsborough alias Oldtown. And a further sum of Twenty pounds Fifteen Shillings and seven pence is payable to Edward Mooney Esq: as owner of the Rectorial Tithes arising out of
