And a further sum of nine pounds Twelve Shillings and sevenpence is payable to Sir George Cockburne Bart. as owner of the Rectorial Tithes arising out of the Townland of Herbert's town in said parish. And a further sum of Three pounds Three Shillings and three pence is due and payable to the Rt. Hon. The Lord Bishop of Kildare as owner of the Tithes arising out of part of the Townland of Kiltbolin (as Extraparochial) in said parish. And also a further sum of Fourteen pounds Eighteen Shillings and four pence is payable to the Reverend James Jones as owner of the Rectorial Tithes arising out of the Townland of Rosetown in said parish.

And I further certify that the average price of wheat being the corn principally grown in such county for the period of seven years ending the first day of November 1830 is Thirty Two Shillings and One Half penny by the Barrel
