




as Extra-parochial in said parish. And also a further sum of
Fourteen pounds Eighteen Shillings and four pence is payable to the
Reverend James Jones as owner of the Rectorial Tithes arising out of
the Groundland of Rosetown in said parish.

And I further certify that the average price of
wheat being the Corn principally Grown in such County for the period
of Seven years ending the first day of November 1830 is Thirty Two
Shillings and One Half penny by the Barrel
