

And a further sum of Ninypounds Twelve Shillings and Sevenpence is payable to Sir George Cockburne Bart as owner of the Rectorial Tithes arising out of the Townland of Herbertstown in said parish. And a further sum of Threepounds Three Shillings and Three pence is due and payable to His Rt Hon<sup>ble</sup> The Lord Bishop of Kildare as owner of the Tithes arising out of part of the Townland of Kibbelin (as Extra Parochial) in said parish.

And also a further sum of Fourteen pounds Eighteen Shillings and four pence is payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> James Jones as owner of the Tithes arising out of the Townland of Rose Town in said parish.

And further Certify that the Average price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven Years ending the first day of November 1830 is Thirty Two Shillings and One half pence by the Barrell
