and nine pence is due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup>  
Thomas Baker as a Composition for the  
Tithes claimable by him as Vicar of the said  
Parish The sum of Twenty nine Pounds seven  
shillings is due and payable to William Dutton  
Pollard Esquire of Castle Pollard in the County  
of Westmeath as a Composition for the Tithes  
of certain Lands in said Parish claimable by  
him as Lay Impropriator and the sum of  
one
