I Samuel Gale Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd year of the reign of King William the 4th / entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th 7th & 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty George the 4th providing for establishing of compositions permanent / to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Hollywood in the County of Wicklow do hereby Certify that the true and just composition for all Tithes within the parish is one hundred and seventy two pounds Six Shillings & Six pence which sum is due and payable to the Honble Mr. James Agar as owner of all Tithes within the said parish and I do further certify that the average price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending 1st November 1830 is and amount to two Shillings and ten pence halfpenny per Barrell
