

Book of Applotment for said Parish be amended by the Annexation thereto of said amended Applotment, and that such amended Applotment do stand in place of the original Book of Applotment, and be valid and effectual to all Intents and purposes for which the said Original Book of Applotment would have been valid and effectual.

And whereas it appears to us by the Certificate of the Composition of the Tithes of the said Parish (an attested Copy whereof has been laid before us) that the said Return purporting to be an Amendment of the Applotment of said Tithes was erroneous, in as much as the said William Whiting and Joseph Nash did applot the Sum of £525 Irish, instead of the Sum of £685 Irish, which last Sum of £685 Irish, is the true amount of the said Composition for the Tithes of said Parish.

We therefore the Lord Lieutenant and Privy Council, Do hereby declare the said Return of the 10th August, 1840, made as aforesaid, by said William Whiting and Joseph Nash, purporting to be an amended Applotment of the Tithe Composition of said Parish of Innishannon, was not a due Execution of the said Orders of 20th August

and 9th of December, 1839, and that the said Order of this Board of the 1st October, 1840, being founded on a Mistake, ought to be and the same is hereby annulled and rescinded.
