

We, William Orr and John Meade  
Commissioners, duly appointed and sworn under and  
by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of  
the reign of King George the Fourth intituled (an  
Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions  
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time) to as-  
certain and fix a true and just Composition for  
all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable  
within the Parish of Innishannon, in the County  
of Cork, do hereby Certify that the true  
and just Amount of Composition for all  
Tithes whatever within the said Parish is  
Six hundred and eighty five Pounds Sterling,  
by the Year.

And we do further certify that the Average  
price of Wheat, being the Corn principally  
grown in such County, for the period of  
Seven years ending the first day of  
November 1821 is thirty eight Shillings and  
eight pence halfpenny per Barrel.

Dated at Innishannon, this 13<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1823.
