



I Samuel Jones Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third William the Fourth entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, Seventh, and Eighth, years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the Establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland, to ascertain and fix a Just, and true Composition for all Tithes, arising, growing, yielding, or payable, within the Parish of Ennisboffin, alias Irish Bofin, in the County of Mayo, do hereby Certify, that the true and Just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever, within the said Parish is nine pounds Twelve Shillings by the year, and I do further Certify, that the average price of oats being the Corn principally grown in this County for the period of Seven years ending on the first day of November 1829 is Eight Shillings per Barrel of fourteen Stone.
