 and Just amount of Composition for all tithes  
 whatever within the said parish consisting of  
 Nine Thousand Nine Hundred and forty Seven Acres  
 One Acre and thirty perches is Six Hundred and  
 thirty Six pounds five Shillings and Nine pence 2d  
 by the year which sum is due and payable to the  
 Honble and Rev. George De la poer Bessford as a  
 Composition for the tithes claimable by him as  
 Rector of the said parish yearly and every year  
 for twenty one years we do hereby certify that the  
 foregoing Valuation and apportionment is a Just and  
 true return as made by us given under our hands  
 this tenth day of April One thousand Eight Hundred  
 and twenty six
