Inas much as I am a Chief Landlord
of the Lands and Premises hereafter mentioned and
described imposed and entitled to a free for, and
undertake the future payment of any Composition for
Tithes charged or which may become chargeable thereon
Take Notice that it is my desire and I hereby agree for
and undertake, the duty and obligation and liability to
the future payment of such Composition as is charged or
or may become chargeable on all that the Lands of Old
Brackly, Threemagillcany, Aigh, Barkillea, Brackly,
Ballymaganna, Cornan, Cinnalia, Cloughbue, Cravobue
Drumahast, Drummorea, Eddergole Garrowhill
Kellestern Longfield, Keshel, Kinnoughtee, Loughill
Lamariagarrow, Largynacarrow, Liskenashan
Lacornee, Largybrack, Mullmacarrow, Meen-
-tashack, Meenatogh Meenapetoo, Meenakillea
Maughery Omeesterna, Roughron Shemaphan
Seadamnan and Stravally, bounded on the South by the
Townlands Croves Teavestictog Cashel and Carran
on the West by Meenaharry Stralinee and the Sea, on
the East by Meenavally Cashel and Maganna and
on the North by the Sea and Ardara and their and
every of their Subdenominations situate lying and
being in the Parish of Ennis Keel of which said Lands
and premises I am the Chief Landlord and owner
in Fee - which said agreement and undertaking I am
so desirous of making in order to be entitled to the
abatement or reduction on such Composition, as by
the Statute in such Case^{is} provided - And I hereby
require you with all convenient Speed after the receipt
hereof to grant to me a Certificate in writing reciting
this Notice and declaring me entitled to the benefit
thereof, such Certificate to be executed under hand
and seal so that I may declare my acceptance
thereof
