 Pounds by the year of which sum of four Hundred & Eighty five Pounds  
 the entire is due and payable to the Revd John Blair Hartney esq  
 Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector & Vicar of  
 the said Parish and we do further certify that the average price of  
 Oats being the Corn principally sown in said counties for the period  
 of seven years ending on the first day of Novr 1823 is  $15 \frac{2}{4}$  lbs  
 per Acre
