Whereas It, Appearing to us Nicholas Purcell
 Gorman Esq. & James Walter Mulleny and Joseph
 Greene Esquires Justices of the Peace presiding at the
 Quarter Sessions for the Peace for the County of Kilkenny
 held at Grace's Old Castle Kilkenny on the Second day
 of April One thousand Eight hundred and thirty Six That
 William Frederick F. Tighe, Joseph Robbins Junr, John Patten
 and Robin Cantwell x x x Owners or occupiers of Land in
 the Parish of Innistiogue in the Diocess of Ossory and County
 of Kilkenny charged with the payment of Three pounds or
 upwards such in respect of Composition for Tithe in said Parish
 caused a Petition in Writing signed by them to be offered
 on Sunday the Thirtieth and Monday the Twenty sixth days of
 March One thousand Eight hundred and thirty Six on the
 principal altar Door of the Church of said Parish of the
 Innistiogue the last of such Sundays not being less than

 Composition for Tithe having made an Application in
 Writing to us the said Justices aforesaid presiding at
 the Quarter Sessions aforesaid held at Grace's Old Castle
 in the County of Kilkenny in which said Parish is situate
 on the Second day of April One thousand Eight hundred
 and Thirty Six to ascertain the average price of Good
 Marketable Wheat as Advertized in the Dublin
