

We the Rev. John Delmege of Gat and John Conolly of Bargin in the County of Galway Esq<sup>rs</sup>  
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the 4<sup>th</sup> year of  
the Reign of Geo<sup>x</sup> IV and the amended acts, Entitled an act to provide for the Establishing of  
Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time / to ascertain and fix a true and Just amount of  
Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielding and payable within the Parish of Isertkelly in the  
Diocese of Kilmacduagh and County of Galway Do hereby certify, that a true and Just amount of  
Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is Forty Pounds sterling, by the year of which  
sum of forty pounds. Thirtyfour pounds sterling is due and payable to the Rev. Edward Hartigan  
as a Composition for <sup>the</sup> tithes claimable by him as Rector &c. of the said Parish and his Successors, and  
Six pounds are due and payable to the Lord Bishop of <sup>the Diocese of</sup> Kilmacduagh and his Successors, And we  
do further certify that the average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown this part of the County  
ending November 1830 is Seven shillings by the Barrel, and we do further certify and agree that this  
Composition shall be and continue without alteration for 21 years from the first of November next  
Signed, sealed and delivered this twentythird day of October One thousand eight hundred and  
thirtytwo
