Diveeese of Kilmacduagh and County of Galway Do hereby certify. that a true and Just amount of
Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is Forty Pounds sterling. by the year of which
sum of Forty pounds. Thirty four pounds sterling is due and payable to the Rev^r Edward Hartigan
as a Composition for tithes claimable by him as Rector &c. of the said Parish and his Successors. and
Sixpounds are due and payable to the Lord Bishop of ^{the Diocese of} Kilmacduagh and his Successors. And we
do further certify that the average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown this part of the County
ending November 1830 is Seven shillings by the Barrel. And we do further certify and agree that this
Composition shall be and Continue without alteration for 21 years from the first of November next
