

Waller and Rowland B. Davenport (three Owners or occupiers of Land in the said Parish of Iveruse charged with payment of £3 or upwards each in respect of such Composition) of an application on behalf of them the said Richard Westropp Reverend John Thomas Waller and Rowland B. Davenport to the Justices of the Peace of the County of Simerick assembled at Quarter Sessions to be held at Rathkale on the 3rd day of October 1889 to have the Tithe Composition and Tithe Rent charge in such Parish varied pursuant to the several acts relating to the Tithe Composition and Tithe Rent charge in Ireland and for that purpose to have the average price of wheat for the seven years preceding the year 1889 inquired of and ascertained in order that the Composition for Tithes and Tithe Rent charge in the said Parish of Iveruse might be varied and diminished for the ensuing 7 Years in proportion to such average price.

And whereas the said Richard Westropp Reverend John Thomas Waller and Rowland B. Davenport afterwards in pursuance of said notice made such application to us the said Justices at said Quarter Sessions assembled in writing for such purpose accordingly.

And whereas the said application having come on for hearing on the said 3rd day of

October 1889 and Mr. Wood G. Jefferson instructed by Messrs. J. Blackall and Son having appeared of Counsel for the said Tithe Rent payers in support of said application and Mr. Condon instructed by Messrs. Dundon and Doyle having appeared of Counsel on behalf of the Lay Impropriator of the said Parish and the said notice of application and Certificate and that the said Richard Westropp Rev^d. John Thomas Waller and Rowland B. Davenport were entitled to make such application having been proved the said Justices granted the application and referred it to Mr. James Greene Barry to ascertain from the Dublin Gazette the average price of wheat for the seven years preceding the 3rd day of October 1889 and make his report in writing thereon to the said Justices at Quarter Sessions assembled.

And whereas the said Justices directed the said James Greene Barry to make his said report to them.

And whereas the said Justices adjourned the said Quarter Sessions to the 30th day of December 1889 And whereas the said James Greene Barry in pursuance of said order on the 25th day of October 1889 duly lodged his report in writing dated the 22nd day of October 1889 Now we the said Justices at
