We John Dinn & John Lathill Commissioners duly
appointed and sworn in and by virtue of an act
made in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George
the fourth entitled an act to provide for the Establishing
& Composition of Tithes in Ireland and also an Amend-
ment of said act passed in the fifth Year of the
Reign of King George the fourth to ascertain and fix
a true and Just Composition for all Tithes arising
growing yielding and payable within the Parish
of Kells in the County of Meath as hereby certify
that the true and Just amount of Composition for
all Tithes whatsoever within said Parish is Three Hundred
and Twenty Two Pounds Twelve Shillings and one half
penny per annum which sum is due and payable
to the Rev^d Thom^s as Rector as Owners of the Rectorial
tithes and Vicar of the Recusant tithes of said Parish
and we do further certify that the said sum of Three
Hundred and Twenty two pounds Twelve Shillings is
a Just and fair Composition for said tithes as agreed
upon at a vestry duly assembled for the full and
term of Twenty one Years from the first day of
November One Thousand Eight Hundred & Twenty
four without any Variation whatsoever
