Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth Entitled an act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a Limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing yielded or payable within the ~~parish~~ parish of Kenmare in the County of Kerry, do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said parish is Two hundred and thirty pounds $\text{£}230$ by the year which sum of Two hundred and thirty pounds $\text{£}230$ is due and payable to the Rev^d William Godfrey as Rector and Vicar of said parish, and we do further Certify that the average price of Oats - being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 - is fifteen Shillings $\text{£}2\ 4$ per Barrel,
