

Certificates of Composition

Robert Reynolds Commissioner in duty
Appointed and sworn under and by Virtue
of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3^d years of
William the 4th Chapter 99 entitled an
Act to amend three Acts passed respectively
in the 4th, 5th and in the 7th and 8th years of
the reign of his late Majesty King George the 4th
providing for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix
a true and just Composition for all Tithes
arising growing appertained or payable within
the Parish of Kilbarney in the County of Down
and Diocess of Raphoe do hereby Certify that the true
and just amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the said Parish as has been
fixed by agreement in Forty five pounds Sterling
by the year of which sum of Forty five pounds
Twenty six pounds are due and payable to
Colonel J. W. Connolly as Composition for all
Tithes claimable by him as lay impropriator
of said Parish. and the sum of Nineteen pounds
Sterling are due and payable to Mr. Theobald
W. Indersich as Composition for all Tithes
claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish
And do further Certify that the average price
of Oats being the Com. Price of Oats in said
County for the period of seven years ending the
11th of November 1830 being in value Shillings and
Eight pence Sterling per Banel.
