the establishing also provision for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time, to ascertain and fix the true and
Just Composition for all Tithes arising growing
yielded or payable within the parishes of Kilkenny
in the County of Tipperary, do hereby Certify that
the true and Just amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatsoever within the said parishes is Three
hundred and Ninety pounds that by the year
of which sum of Three hundred and Ninety pounds
and payable to the said Church as also provision for two
thirds of the Tithes claimed by him as deriving under
the Lay Impropriation of said Church and One hundred and
thirty pounds that an demand payable to the said Church
as also provision for one third part of the
Tithes as value of the said parishes, and do further
Certify that the average sum of what being the same
principally grows in said County for the parishes of
such year ending on the first day of November
one thousand eight hundred and twenty one
is One pound Eighty seven and two pence half penny
