

We the Revd. John Delmege and John Bunk Esq. Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth entitled "An Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the parish of Killeacounty in the County of Galway do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever of the lands of Killaheen, ^{and} Gorticaman lying and being within the said parish is twenty pounds by the year: which sum of twenty pounds is due and payable to the Reverend Robert King as Archdeacon of Kilmacduagh and his Successors. And we do further certify that the average price of wheat, being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the period of seven years, ending on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty one is one pound eighteen shillings and eight pence ^{per barrel} half penny as taken from the Dublin Gazette given under our hands this fifth day of May one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven.
