

Thomas Daly Commissioner duly appointed
and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the second
and third year of the reign of his present Majesty King
William the fourth entitled an act to amend three acts passed
respectively in the fourth fifth and seventh and eighth year
of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for a
composition for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compo-
sition permanent to ascertain and set a true and just
composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding or
payable within the parish of Kilbeacan in the County
of Kilkenny do certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish
is one Hundred and fourteen Pounds of which sum of one
Hundred and fourteen Pounds one third part or Thirty-
eight Pounds is due and payable to the Reverend Anthony
Pack L.L.D. as Composition claimable by him as Vicar
of the said Parish and two third part or seventy six Pounds
is due and payable to John Sylmer Esq as lay Proprietor
of the vicarial Tithes of the said Parish,
And I do further certify that the average price of ~~wheat~~^{wheat}
being the corn principally grown in said County for
the period ending November the 1st 1830 is thirty two shillings
and eleven pence half penny
per barrel
