of Parliament for providing for the establishing of composition for tithes
in Ireland to ascertain & fix a true and just composition for all tithes
arising growing payable or payable within the Parish of Hillinny in the
County of Wicklow and Diocese of Dublin

I do hereby certify that the true & just amount of
composition for all tithes ^{whenever} within the said Parish is Three Hundred and
Sixty Pounds Sterling by the year of which sum of Three Hundred & Sixty Pounds
Two Shillings or two Hundred & Forty Pounds Sterling are payable to
Messrs. Vessey & Co. as composition for the tithes claimable by his ex-

cellent Lord Bishop of Down and Connor and twenty pounds Sterling
and payable to the Rev. Thomas Kingsbury Arch. Deacon of Hillinny as
composition for the tithes claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish
to be continued invariable for Twenty one years - And we do
further certify that the average price of wheat being the crop sown
- yearly grown in such County for the period of seven years ending
on the first day of November 1821 is Thirty Shillings per Barrel
