within the Parish of Kilbolane, in the County of Cork
Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of
Composition, for all Tithes wholsum within said
Parish is Five hundred and fifty pounds the yearly sum
and payable to George Bruce Esq^r of Milltown Castle in the
County of Cork, the Lay Impropriator of said Tithes for
and during the term of Twenty one years from the date
hereof Given under our hands this 13th day of June 1830 -
