

All Tithes, whatever within the same Parish
 Three Shillings and Eight pence, namely,
 Three Shillings and Eight pence by the year
 of which sum of £388. 3. 9, the sum of
 Two Hundred and Eighty Pence, the
 Shillings and pence, the amount of
 Tithes, is due and payable to the
 Reverend William A. Arch. Vicar of said Parish,
 and the same is due and payable to the
 same by virtue of a Certificate dated the 23rd day
 of February 1825 & a corresponding application
 both deposited in the Office of the Registrar
 of the Diocese of Cork, the amount of
 the aforesaid sum of £388. 3. 9, that is to say,
 the sum of One Hundred and Eighty Pence,
 being the amount of Tithes, formerly
 Improperly Tithes of said Parish, since

1st due and payable to the said Rev. William A. Arch.
 Vicar, having been of said Parish, is due and payable
 and by virtue of the said papers on the 14th 3rd
 15th of said King Charles 2nd Chapter Two
 and Section 10th of said Statute for the C. of
 that the average price of Wheat, during
 the same year, ended a Quarter 1831 was
 £1. 12. 0th of Barrell, and that the average
 price of Oats, during the same period, was
 12. 11th of Barrell, Wheat and Oats being
 the most principally grown in said County
 of Cork.
