

Certificate signed the 20th of April 1826

We John A. Agar of Ballyhar and Geoffrey Lynch
of Drogheda Esqrs. Commissioners duly appointed and sworn
under and by virtue of an Act or Acts made in the
fourth and fifth years of the reign of his present
Majesty George the fourth intitled an Act to provide
for the establishing of Compensation for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and
just Compensation for all Tithes arising growing yielding
and payable within the Parish of Miltmain in the County
of Kerry and united Division of Arafert and Aghadac
do hereby certify that the true and just amount of
annual Compensation for the Rev. John Moores vicarual
moiety or part of the Tithes within said Parish is one
hundred and eighty-four pounds twelve Shillings British
Currency and which sum is to be

paid Half yearly as directed
under said Acts of Parliament, and we do further certify
that the average Price of oats (being the Corn principally
grown in such County) for the period of Seven years
ending the 1st day of November 1821 is fifteen
Shillings and two pence farthing p Barrel Leated
this 20th day of April 1826
