Act of the last Session of Parliament to provide for the Establishing of
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, to ascertain and fix a true and
just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable
within the Parish of Kilbride, being part of the Union of Ardara, in
the County of Wick, to the Rev^d George Leslie Gifford Vicar of said
Union of Ardara. Do hereby Certify that an Agreement has been
entered into on the part of the said Rev^d George Leslie Gifford
Vicar of said Union of Ardara to accept of the Sum of one
hundred and thirty pounds by the year for twenty one years, as a
Composition for the Tithes claimable by him from the said
Parish of Kilbride as Vicar of said Union of Ardara. We
therefore hereby further Certify that the true and just Amount
of Composition for all Tithes claimable by him as Vicar of said
Union of Ardara within the said Parish of Kilbride is one
hundred and thirty pounds by the year of which Sum the
Whole one hundred and thirty pounds is due and payable
to him as Vicar of said Union of Ardara.
