I, Samuel Gordon, Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of King William fourth intituled an Act to Amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent: to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilbride in the County of Kilkenny, Diocese of Ossory do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Ninety pounds Sterling by the year of which Sum of Ninety pounds a moiety or one half is due and payable to the Reverend John Deby as Owner of the Rectorial Tithes of the said Parish who has set the said Rectorial Tithes to
