Whereas St George Caulfield Esq of Donamoon in the County  
 of Roscommon heretofore to wit on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February  
 1833 served a notice upon the Alexander Sands Esq Impropriator  
 of the Parish of Kilbride in the Words of figures following that is  
 to say Sir You are hereby Required, to take Notice that in  
 Obedience of an Act passed in the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> years of the Reign  
 of his Majesty King William the 4<sup>th</sup> entitled an Act to  
 Amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>  
 and in the 14<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> years of the Reign of his late Majesty  
 King George the 4<sup>th</sup> Providing for the Establishing of Compoise  
 for Tithes in Ireland, & to make such Compoise Permanent  
 I being Chief Landlord seized in fee simple of all that those  
 the Lands of Carronward, Carronard, Tully & Cagglebeg. The Metes  
 & Bounds whereof are as follows that is to say Bounded on the  
 North by Tinnoc & Clooneraagh on the South by Carstein on the  
 East by Lettrim & on the West by Ballyglaf - Situate in the Parish  
 of Kilbride & Barony of Ballentober County of Roscommon. or being  
 otherwise entitled according to the Provisions of the said Act to sign  
 for & undertake the Payment of the Compoise of Tithes lawfully  
 payable for & in Respect of the said Lands, do hereby
