I do hereby Certify that the true and just amount  
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said  
Parish is One Hundred and sixty four Pounds Three  
Shillings and two pence halfpenny by the year, which  
sum is due and payable to James Kearney Esq. of  
Graceview as Lay Rector of the Economy of the  
Cathedral Church of Waterford, being the average  
of the sums agreed for and paid to the said James  
Kearney for the seven years successively previous to  
the 1st day of November 1830 - And I do hereby  
further Certify that the average price of Oats
