 and four pence by the year which sum is
 due and payable to the Reverend Canonry of St. Dunstons
 as a composition for the tithes claimable by him
 as Rector of the said Parish

And we do further Certify that the
 average price of Wheat has been one pound eighteen
 shillings and eight pence half penny per barrel
 and that the average price of Oats has been fifteen
 shillings and two pence farthing per barrel for
 the period of Seven years ending the first day
 of November 1821 as extracted from the Dublin
 Gazette — Dated this 23rd day of October 1823
