which sum of Ninety pounds one half thereof is due
and payable the Rev Henry Bumbery the Vicar
the other half of said Ninety pounds is due and
payable to James Bumbery the lessee of the
Rectorial tithes of said Parish And we do further
certify that the average price of Wheat being the
Corn principally grown in such County for the
period of Seven Years ending on the first day of
May last is one pound seven ^{shillings} ~~per~~ barrel
