

Mr. Longfield heard in reply
Whereupon on reading the said conditional
order the affidavit mentioned in and
grounding the said conditional order of
Henry Harte Barry filed the 1st December
1890 the cause affidavit referred to in
notice of Nicholas Waters Keller filed the
3rd January 1891 and the supplemental affidavit
in support of Conditional order of Henry Harte
Barry filed the 15th January 1891 by leave
of the 12th.

It is ordered, that the Cause shewn
be disallowed and that the said conditional
order be and the same is hereby made
absolute, And It is accordingly ordered
that a writ of Certiorari do issue directed
to the Recorder and Justices in the title
hereof named to remove into the Division
here All and Singular orders and adjudications
of the said Recorder and Justices made at
a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace
held at Kautink on or about the 23rd June
1890 and at Mallon on or about the 3rd
November 1890 granting the application
of William Norton Barry William Sankay
and Nicholas Leader for an order varying
and diminishing the Tithe composition

and Tithe Rent charge in the Parish
of Kilbrin and County of Cork, And
All and Singular ^{other} ~~other~~ orders and adjudications
in the premises with all things touching
the same

And by consent of Counsel at
both sides It is ordered that when removed
into the Division here all and Singular
orders and adjudications in the premises
do stand quashed upon ex parte motion
without further argument in that behalf
The said Richard Edmund Longfield
to have as against the applicants in the
Court below the said William Norton
Barry William Sankay and William
Leader his costs here to be taxed by the
Master of the Crown Office
