By the Justices of the Peace for the County of Cork assembled
 at a General Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for Cork County
 East Riding and Division of Mallow the third day of June
 one thousand eight hundred and ninety -

Whereas by a certificate in writing under his hand and
 seal made and dated the twenty first day of January one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty four, Valentine Stines the
 Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under the Statutes in
 that behalf made and provided to ascertain and fix a true
 and just Composition for all tithes arising yielding yielded
 and payable within the Parish of Kilbrin in the County of Cork
 did Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes
 which within said Parish is nine hundred and forty three pounds seven
 shillings and ten pence sterling by the year of which sum four hundred
 and twenty pounds is due and payable to the Reverend Nicholas Wilson
 as a Composition by agreement entered into in the year one thousand
 eight hundred and thirty for tithes claimable by him as Vicar of
 said Parish and the sum of five hundred and twenty three pounds
 seven shillings and ten pence sterling by the year is due and payable
 to the representatives of the late James Roche the executor of the late
 Richard Longfield of Longquente in the County of Cork the lay impropriator
 of said parish as a Composition on the average for the tithes claimable
 by them for the lay impropriate tithes of said parish and did further
 certify so agreed that the average price of wheat being the Corn principally
 grown in the County of Cork aforesaid for the period of seven years
 ending the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and
 thirty is one pound twelve shillings and three pence half penny
 per barrel and whereas said Compositions for tithes have since
 been abolished and rent charges substituted in lieu thereof under
 and by virtue of the Statutes in that behalf made and provided and
 whereas by notice in writing given under their hands and published
 posted and affixed upon the principal outer door of the Parish Church
 of said Parish of Kilbrin at the times and in the manner prescribed
 by the Statutes to that intent made and provided William Arthur
 Barr
