



Barry of Coshcor in the County of Cork William Sautkey of  
Walcot Pray in the County of Wicklow and William N Leader of  
Dromagh in the County of Cork being three persons in said parish  
each charged with the annual payment of three pounds and upwards  
in respect of said rent charge in said parish do signify their intent  
to make application to the Justices of the Peace assembled at the  
next ensuing Quarter Sessions of the Peace at Kautunk in and for said  
Cork County East Riding and Division of Mallow being the County Riding  
and division in which said Parish is situate on the twenty third day  
of June one thousand eight hundred and ninety to have the average price  
of wheat (being the grain in said original Certificate mentioned) for  
the seven years preceding inquired of and ascertained in order that  
the amount of said tithe composition and the tithe rent charge in  
lieu thereof leviable or payable out of the lands in said Parish of  
Kilbrin may be varied and increased or diminished for the next  
ensuing seven years in proportion to such average price, And  
Whereas the said William N Barry William Sautkey and William  
N Leader in pursuance of said notice duly made application in  
writing to us the said Justices at the Quarter Sessions of the Peace  
held on the twenty third day of June one thousand eight hundred  
and ninety at Kautunk in and for said County Riding and Division  
for such purpose accordingly And Whereas upon reading  
said original Certificate notice and application and upon  
proof that said notices were duly posted and affixed and said  
application lodged and that said William N Barry William  
Sautkey and William N Leader are persons each charged with the  
annual payment of three pounds and upwards in respect of rent  
charges payable in lieu of tithe composition in said Parish and  
upon hearing Mr Laurence Counsel for said applicants and  
Mr Longfield Counsel on behalf of Richard E Longfield the  
person claiming to be entitled to the portion of said rent charge  
substituted for and payable in lieu of said lay impropriate  
tithes and the composition therefor We the said Justices  
did order and direct that the average price of the barrel of  
good marketable wheat for the seven years preceding said  
application be enquired of and ascertained and did proceed  
to inquire and ascertain same accordingly and at the request  
of the said parties did nominate and appoint James Green  
Barry of Sandville in the County of Lincoln to be an arbitrator  
for ascertaining the average price of the barrel of good marketable  
wheat from the Dublin Gazette for the seven years preceding said  
application and did order and direct the said James Green Barry  
to ascertain same accordingly and to state and set forth such  
average price by his report in writing under his hand to be delivered  
to us said Justices at the present Quarter Sessions of the Peace  
and
