said James Green Barry has delivered to us at these present Quarter
Sessions of the Peace his report in writing under his hand of and
concerning the premises dated the ~~14th~~^{15th} day of September one
thousand eight hundred and ninety and has therein certified to
us that he has personally examined the Dublin Gazettes and has
therefrom ascertained the average price of the barrel of good marketable
wheat for the seven years preceding said application and has stated
and set forth such average price as ascertained as aforesaid to be
eighteen shillings and seven pence NOW we the said
Justices at these present Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for
said County, Riding and Division assembled (being the County,
Riding and Division in which said Parish of Kilbrin is situate)
do hereby find and declare that the average price of the barrel
of good marketable wheat for the seven years preceding said
application was eighteen shillings and seven pence and we
do order that the amount of the composition for tithes and the rent
charge payable in lieu thereof in said parish of Kilbrin be
varied and diminished in such manner and to such extent
that the amount of such composition and rent charge payable
for and during the next ensuing seven years that is to say from
the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and ninety
shall bear the like proportion to the amount of the composition set
forth in said original certificate as the said average price of the
barrel of good marketable wheat ascertained by and stated and
set forth in said certificate of said James Green Barry heretofore
mentioned and hereby found and declared by us that is to say
eighteen shillings and seven pence bears to the price thereof
set forth in such original certificate of said Valentine Hines
that is to say one pound twelve shillings and three pence halfpenny
and that the assessment and apportionment of such composition and
rent charge shall be varied and diminished so as to bear the like
proportion to the amount of such new and varied composition and
rent charge payable for and during said next ensuing seven
years as the original assessment and apportionment did bear to such
original composition in said original certificate mentioned.
