composition or the Averages for the tythes claimable by
them, for the Law Impropriate Tythes of each Parish—
And further certify, that the average price of Wheat,
being the Commonly sown in the County of Cork
of each year, for the period of Seven years, ending the first
day of November One thousand Eight Hundred & Thirty,
is One pound, twelve shillings, and three pence halfpenny
per Borell — Dated this Twentieth first day of January
